Dear Old West Enders.

When you tell the story of the Old West End, where do you begin? Who are the heroes and who are the villains? What influxes of people have shaped the way we live here? What's the narrative arc, a decline and resurgence of a beautiful neighborhood or a transformation from one thing to another? One thing we might all agree upon, despite the particular storylines we might follow, is that the Old West End has a story that needs to be told.

We have a chance this year for our stories to be recorded and retold. Thanks to the tireless efforts of Dan Finkel and Lindsay Miller and thanks to generous gifts from neighbors and corporate sponsors, WGTE will produce a Toledo Story about the Old West End. WGTE has done a remarkable job documenting Toledo History in thirty minute segments. The Old West End plays a key role in the Toledo Story on the Fair Housing Center, where the narrative threads of race, access, and justice propelled Marcie Fein and others to begin this impressive organization. It is time for a story centered on this place we love which picks up some of those threads and presents more stories about where the Old West End came from and how it has been shaped through the years.

With Dan's leadership, we have come together to make this documentary happen. Members of the OWE Association voted to help fund this project as part of our budget for 2023. So far we have 19 neighbors who have given truly generous gifts toward this project. Here's what Dan posted on the Old West End Facebook about this: "I believe that in the end the people that live here can account for nearly a third of the project at \$12,000. My ask is that the number of participants be more like 100." With another 81 gifts towards this project we can raise an additional \$4000 and show the rest of our City what we think of this place we share. Well, make that 80. I'm giving a gift right now through the Old West End website. I hope you'll join me in making a contribution; whatever that might look like for you. We have an important story to share with the rest of our city.

### "Coalition for Peaceful Toledo Neighborhoods"

Four of our retired Mayor's (Paula Hicks Hudson, Mike Bell, Donna Owens & Carty Finkbeiner along with many Community & Church leaders have met with many neighborhoods to gather information from those who attended the meetings on what efforts would be the best to promote peace and eliminate deaths by gun violence in Toledo Neighborhoods.

The following is the Ordinance request presented to Mayor Wade Kapszukiewicz and City Council.

**Purpose:** The Purpose of this ordinance is to express support for the Coalition for Peaceful Toledo Neighborhoods in its efforts to promote peace and eliminate deaths by violence in the City of Toledo and to provide resources as necessary to implement community-driven initiatives aimed at reducing violence and promoting peace.
