

Dear Old West Enders.

Last month at the Old West End Association meeting we got a chance to learn about belonging. Belonging, according to some definitions, relates to the deep human need for acceptance in a group or community. According to the Toledo Museum of Art's first ever Director of Belonging, **Rhonda Sewell**, belonging is also an active word. It takes discipline, diligence, and consistency in order to make the space for people to feel like they belong.

Rhonda shared the story of how she landed up in this job which wove together so many of her astonishing range of experiences and gifts. From writing at the Blade to advocating for the library before governmental decision-makers, she always urged people to tell bigger stories about who matters and what is important. As the Director of Belonging at the TMA, she gets to assemble a team from all levels of the museum's structure to ask probing questions about Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Access. This team even subjects the Museum's Strategic Plan to analysis through each of these lenses.

Rhonda also acknowledged that 'belonging' has not always been a priority at the Museum. When asked how she builds trust in communities that have not historically seen the TMA as a place they might belong, Rhonda replied: consistency. Show up, early, over and over again so that people gradually begin to trust that you're really there to share something beautiful and build an on-going, mutual relationship. Rhonda said, on behalf the Museum, she wants to earn that kind of trust with us, too. She is not alone in this either, TMA Director, Adam Levine, will hold a special, in-person ask me anything event at 7 PM on October 12th where he will field all your questions about the Museum and

After Rhonda presented, a number of people shared with me that her focus on consistency in building relationships and promoting an active sense of belonging through DEAI accountability

challenged them to reflect on their own organizations. I certainly did. We cannot expect the neighbors who live outside the Historic District to trust that we really think of them as Old West Enders unless we consistently show up, seek their input, and welcome their leadership. I learned from Toledo Design Collective that we need to demonstrate our willingness and ability to build relationships with neighbors who have traditionally been left out of OWE leadership and planning before their board would agree to partner with us. So we have work to do.

That starts with me and the OWE Association Board. We need to meet new neighbors and new leaders. I hope to see you at an upcoming concert at Glenwood Park. We're going to move the Annual Picnic meeting to Macelwane Park this year and include more games. And I also hope to see you at porch crawls and Music in the Park. Let us know where you gather and I will come with another representative from the board to hear your experience of this neighborhood and to ask what belonging might feel like for you. "Love is an active word, like struggle." Come join in this kind of struggle at the Old West End Association. The Old West Enders Litter League team was formed last year by Dan LaCerva. After lamenting about the amount of trash

found all over the neighborhood to his wife, Dan was challenged by her to do something about it. The City launched the Litter League program last year as a friendly competition for neighborhoods to pick up litter across the city. Dan got a team registered for the 43620/43610 zip codes and completed semiweekly cleanups on weeknights throughout the summer. Fast forward to 2022 and Old West End Association Trustee, Andrew Larsen, reached out to Dan about the Litter League cleanups. Andrew had the OWEA adopt the I-75 ramps at Bancroft and at Collingwood through ODOT but wanted to work on other areas of the neighborhood as well. Teaming up with Dan, they have organized five Saturday morning pickups around the neighborhood. Since

May, 78 bags of litter have been picked up along the two exit ramps, in Collingwood Springs, and down Bancroft, Lawrence, Ashland, Maplewood, Delaware and Detroit. There have been over 30 different neighborhood resident volunteers that have shown up for the clean up dates. Keep Toledo Lucas County Beautiful and ODOT have provided the team with trash grabbers, bags, and gloves. Picking up litter in the neighborhood is just one of the many ways that residents can show pride in where they live and can come together as a community to meet new people and make an immediate impact.
