As the year draws to a close, so, too, does my term as President of the Old West End Association. I have thoroughly enjoyed my tenure and was honored that you asked me to step up again. I am equally delighted that some others are taking a turn. Thank you to our incoming and first-term incoming President, Sara Haynes, and new Vice President and President-Elect, Chris Hanley, as well as to all of the new and returning officers, trustees, and committee chairs.

During the past two years, we set out to accomplish a number of goals for the neighborhood. These included:

- 1) Enhancing awareness and dispelling confusion about the boundaries of the neighborhood, i.e., that the historic district is a small part of a much larger area and our efforts should touch the entire neighborhood
- 2) Promoting diversity, inclusion, and tolerance among our neighbors
- 3) Increasing preservation related activities
- 4) Strengthening our Entrepeneurship (now Business Networking) Committee
  - 5) Engaging neighbors

From my perspective, we have made strides forward in each of these areas, creating new events (like the Macelwane AfterParty), creating a Board seat for an OWENI representative, hosting a community conversation on civility in social media, partnering with Old Towne and the Land Bank to engage in ongoing salvage activities, hosting the Autumn Market, and changing the format and location of our monthly meetings. All of the aforementioned items have fostered a greater cohesiveness within our community.

Of course, there's much more to do in this regard. The Strategic Plan developed in the beginning of 2019 provides a roadmap of goals and the steps we hope to take to reach them. It's a straightforward yet ambitious document designed to evolve as we do. I look forward to continuing to work with the OWEA as we keep pushing forward—especially that I can now legitimately state that "I'm not in charge, but I am responsible" (most of the time anyway) (••).

The Agnes Reynolds Jackson Arbore-

tum now proudly boasts its namesake in the form of a beautiful sign adorning the entranceway. Thank you to the Arboretum Committee, and Kent Illenden, for making this vision a reality. It's a beautiful recognition of a gracious gift that we all enjoy.

Collins to the east side of Robinwood to Islington, Islington west to Glenwood, Glenwood to Monroe St.

If you live within these boundaries, know that you are living within the Historic District of the OWE.

#### **BANCROFT STREET**

Much to the outrage of the Bancroft Beautification Team and many neighbors the Stop Signs at Scottwood and Bancroft were removed without any notification from the city. Sadly this is how Transportation has handled several issues brought to their attention. Including a line of sight issue at Bancroft & Scottwood Ave. on the side of Ann Manor. We are not going away from this as it is a very real safety issue for our residential neighborhood.

We have made contact with Marcy Kaptur's office (she sits on the Transportation Committee for the State). Letters have been written to the Blade. The Ability Center has been contacted along with Fair Housing. Yvonne Harper, Councilwoman for District 4 has asked for and has not received any answers from the Mayors' Office. She isn't going away either. Stay tuned, we are working on some other things and will need the support of all neighbors as we go forward with this horrendous safety issue for residents with disabilities, families, bikers etc.


