



WOWE is very grateful to **Scott & Tammy Michalak** for all of your time, talent and installation efforts of this marvelous, newest addition for the Common's Park!


The Library is filled with wonderful books. Make time for a visit and select few children's books if you have a chance. If you have some to exchange, please do that too!
