I am excited to begin this year as the Vice President of LSS. In planning for future programming, I reflect on what the agency has accomplished thus far.

As we begin the 110th year of LSSNWO, we have a great deal to be thankful for. We have been blessed with 109 years of successful program services supported by generous donors and congregations. In the past year we have been able to adapt programming needs to meet current community concerns.

With the addition of **COVID-19 Rental Assistance grants**, we have been able to keep hundreds of families housed. We are making an impact on the financial stability of those clients receiving the rental assistance funding.

Providing **Mental Health services** continues to be a program for LSS, and there has been an even greater need of this service for individuals recently. We've adapt-

ed to telephonic and teletherapy services and many clinicians are doing so both in the office and remotely.

We've adapted our **Food Pantry Program** multiple times to serve clients in the safest way possible given the current status of the pandemic.

The future is clearly in front of us as we continue on the path of serving individuals and families with current and relevant programming. We will continue to be cognizant of current issues to insure the effectiveness of services provided. We are constantly forging new collaborations and working relationships with other agencies and businesses in the communities we serve.

Our headquarters has been located in the Old West End since 1969 and we are proud to call it "our" neighborhood. We look forward to seeing the possibilities as we work together to improve our community for years to come.

Make June jolly, jammy, 'jabby' and tell a few jokes along the way! AND GET VACCINATED!




#### OLD WEST END SECURITY
