

GREAT NEWS ABOUT BANCROFT


This committee is working with the city to find a permanent solution for the concerns that have been raised about the intersection of Bancroft and Scottwood. The group received a phone call from phone call from Abby Arnold, Deputy Chief of Staff, City of Toledo, on Friday, 2/14. She was able to share with them the intended resolution for Scottwood and Bancroft. Due to the line of site issues that exist, Abby is working with the Department of Transportation to install an actuated signal at the intersection. (Signal would be green unless a car or pedestrian is seen and would change to red on Bancroft to allow crossing). Because the intersection does not meet any of the manual warrants, the cost for installation and maintenance must be 100% borne by the City of Toledo. The estimated cost for installation is \$150,000. Their understanding is that Abby has communicated with Councilwoman Harper who will need to work with Council to make a line item adjustment to the budget before we can proceed and that Councilwoman Harper was willing to do so. If other Council members should push back we will be needed, along with members of the community, to help Council understand the importance of funding this light for the safety of our community. Abby estimated it may take up to 2 months for the actual funding and installation to occur and that she will also work to see what interim measures may be needed at the intersection until the signal is installed. She indicated she would keep us updated on any progress/ changes.

WOWE members and Council Woman Yvonnne Harper are still pursuing the issue of a 60 Unit Apartment Building which will house felons coming out of prison or jail. This proposed facility is intended to be build at Woodruff and Franklin. None of the adojoining property owners had any knowledge of this including the businesses on Adams St. in UpTown. Manos Greek Restaurant is one block away at Franklin an Adams St. WOWE has filed an appeal to the Plan Commission who approved this facility. There will be more information about this current situation in the April Newsletter.


