

Dear Old West Enders,

At the end of 2021, Tanasio Loudermill, Old West End Association VP, created a survey that went out through Facebook, email, and direct invitations to get feedback on how you engage with the OWE Association and what gets in the way. We received approximately 40 responses in 5000 person area, which to non-specialist seems low but I'm told is an average response rate for such a survey. To all of you who took the time to complete this survey and share their hopes for and critiques of the Old West End Association and its Board: thank you. You shaped my thinking about our neighborhood, both in terms of what to prioritize and how to communi-

The Board had a lot to learn from this survey. We saw the appearance of what I think of as "multiple Old West Ends" inside the Old West End. One person might be living one street west of another and have very different experience of this community. We also learned that many of you were hungry for a clearer plan and for stronger action in shaping the place we share.

To address both the questions around whom the Old West End Association is for and how we should take strong action to benefit our whole community, we need your help. The OWE Association Board will undergo one of our largest strategic planning processes to date in terms of the desired scope of participation.

First, each of the committees of the Old West End will get a chance to undergo a design thinking process with Dustin Hostetler and a few other facilitators. Through conversation, these sessions will be shaped into strategic plans and eventually funding requests for our budgeting process. This side of the process will dig deep into that desire for bolder actions as a neighborhood. If you're involved in one of our committees (like Preservation, Arboretum, or Education) you've probably heard about this process, and we'll be relying on your input.

The other side of this planning process is a survey for you and for all our neigh-

bors to complete. This short questionnaire aims to go as wide as possible, going beyond the Histroic District while including preservation as a key strategic planning topic. While it will begin with some demographic information, its important to note it will be anonymous. The Board wants to be intentional about listening to voices from beyond the Historic District, a group historically overrepresented in Association decisions. Afterwards, you'll get a chance to share what is your favorite thing about the neighborhood and what you believe is the biggest challenge we face. Then we ask you to share what the OWE Association could do to be more welcoming and to list your ideas for what you see as our highest priorities for sustained work.

Last survey we got 40 participants. At an average porch crawl maybe we get 100 or so people. Would you help us reach 200 responses? It will take about five minutes and the only effort will be sharing your dreams for this neighborhood and the QR Code is right here! Please join me in



taking this step towards neighborhood you dream the Old West End can be.




